We have been given the fabulous opportunity to visit the Houses of Parliament to enhance our learning about Democracy, which has been part of our Ancient Greece topic.

We will be travelling by public transport from Gordon Hill to Westminster and travelling within school hours, so children should arrive at school in the morning at the usual time and will return in time for normal pick up time. The Office will text you if we are significantly delayed.

As with all trips, children who have selected to have a school dinner will receive a school packed lunch. Please ensure you select either a tuna or cheese sandwich when making your choices for that week. Please note if you choose a hot meal, your child will be automatically given a cheese sandwich. The school packed lunch is provided in a paper bag; as these invariably tear during the journey, please provide your child with a suitable carrier bag to use.

There is no cost for this trip, but you will need to <u>please give your consent for this visit via</u> <u>Parentpay</u>. This needs to be completed by Friday 26th April.

Your son/daughter will need to wear full school uniform and a coat.
