Dear Year 3-5 Parents/Carers,

We're excited to announce that, thanks to Into Film, we have the opportunity to attend a free trip to Cineworld Enfield!

Into Film is an organisation dedicated to inspiring and engaging children through the power of film, helping to support their educational development in a unique way. This trip will allow pupils to experience storytelling on the big screen, encouraging critical thinking, creativity, and discussion about the narrative elements and themes presented in the film.

On Wednesday, 20th November, pupils in Years 3, 4, and 5 will watch *Dogtanian and The Three Muskehounds*, a film that ties in with their learning and offers a fun and engaging way to explore story structure, character development, and themes of teamwork and bravery.

Trip Details:

- **Arrival at School:** Please ensure your child arrives at school by 8:45 a.m. for a prompt departure at 9:00 a.m. The gates will open at 8:40 a.m.
- **Preparation:** We kindly ask that all children use the toilet before coming to school and have had a good breakfast to set them up for the day.
- **Departure:**
 - Year 3 will travel by bus to Cineworld Enfield.
 - Years 4 and 5 will walk from St. Michael's School to the cinema, so please ensure your child is prepared for the journey.
- **Return and Lunch:** The children will be back at school in time for lunch. The school will provide a packed lunch for all pupils, unless your child usually brings their own packed lunch.
- **Clothing:** Children should wear suitable footwear to ensure they're comfortable throughout the walk (e.g., trainers) and bring a raincoat.
- **Snacks:** Children may bring a water bottle and one piece of fruit to enjoy during the screening.
- **Volunteers Needed:** We welcome any parents who would like to join us as volunteers for the walk to and from the cinema. However, please note that due to ticket availability, not all adults will be able to watch the screening. For those volunteers who cannot join us in the cinema, there is a Starbucks inside the venue where you are welcome to wait until the screening ends. - **Consent:** Please use ParentPay to provide consent for your child to attend this trip. There is no cost for the trip, but we do need all consents submitted by Monday, 18th November.
