Children under the age 5 can attend for free if sat on the lap of a parent, please select an 'Infant' ticket.

Key Information: The children will be going for a rehearsal at City of London school on **22nd April** and will be leaving at 9.30am for that day and will return by 4pm. Children will be having a packed lunch so please completed the packed lunch option on ParentPay. If you are planning to supply your child with a packed lunch from home, please mention on the ParentPay consent.

We will be leaving school at 1pm after having an early normal lunch at school. (you do not need to select a packed lunch option for this visit) Parents can collect the children after the service at 7.40pm. If children are coming back to school, they will return by 9pm to Gordon Hill.

Children will need to have a **pack tea** brought in from home and water bottle to take for the evening.
