St Michael's School Governors' Maintenance Fund

What is the Maintenance Fund?

As a voluntary aided school, repairs to the fabric and structure of the school buildings are paid for via the London Diocesan Board for Schools. The LDBS provides not only the funding, but vital expertise in tendering for and managing the repair projects.

To receive this funding, St Michael's must meet its contribution to the collective fund – calculated by the LDBS based on the number of students. This required contribution now exceeds **£11,000** annually.

This funding is collected by the contributions made by parents / guardians to the maintenance fund via the ParentPay site. Found at <http://www.parentpay.com>

What is the Amount of the Contribution?

The governors have voted to maintain the contribution at a level of £40 per child, as it was for the 2021/2022 academic year. We understand the additional difficulties that parents / guardians may face this year in making their contribution, and thus remain extremely grateful to all those who are able to continue to support the maintenance fund. If we are fortunate enough to accumulate a surplus, this will be used to meet the many other maintenance and safety projects around the school.

What Does the Maintenance Fund Provide?

The funding provided allows the school to repair, update and maintain the school buildings to a standard that is safe and provides a suitable learning environment for the students. While we are fortunate to enjoy a modern building, the school is now 9 years old and requirements for repairs increase year on year.

Projects which have used LDBS funding for repair over the last few years include:

- Boundary fence replacement
- Underground drainage repairs
- Roofing and flooring replacement in the EYFS building

How Can the Fund Reclaim Gift Aid on My Donation?

Reclaiming Gift Aid is a vital source of money for the fund. For all basic tax rate payers who make a donation, approximately 20% can be reclaimed by the fund - making a huge difference to the amount collected.

Simply fill out the details on the Gift Aid Form, which is copied on the back of this letter, specifying the amount of your most recent donation, and this will allow the fund to reclaim from HMRC a proportion of what you have donated (and subsequent donations) **at no cost to yourself**.

On behalf of the Board of Governors, we would like to thank you for your continued generosity; we remain hugely appreciative of the support offered to the school by the parents and guardians.
